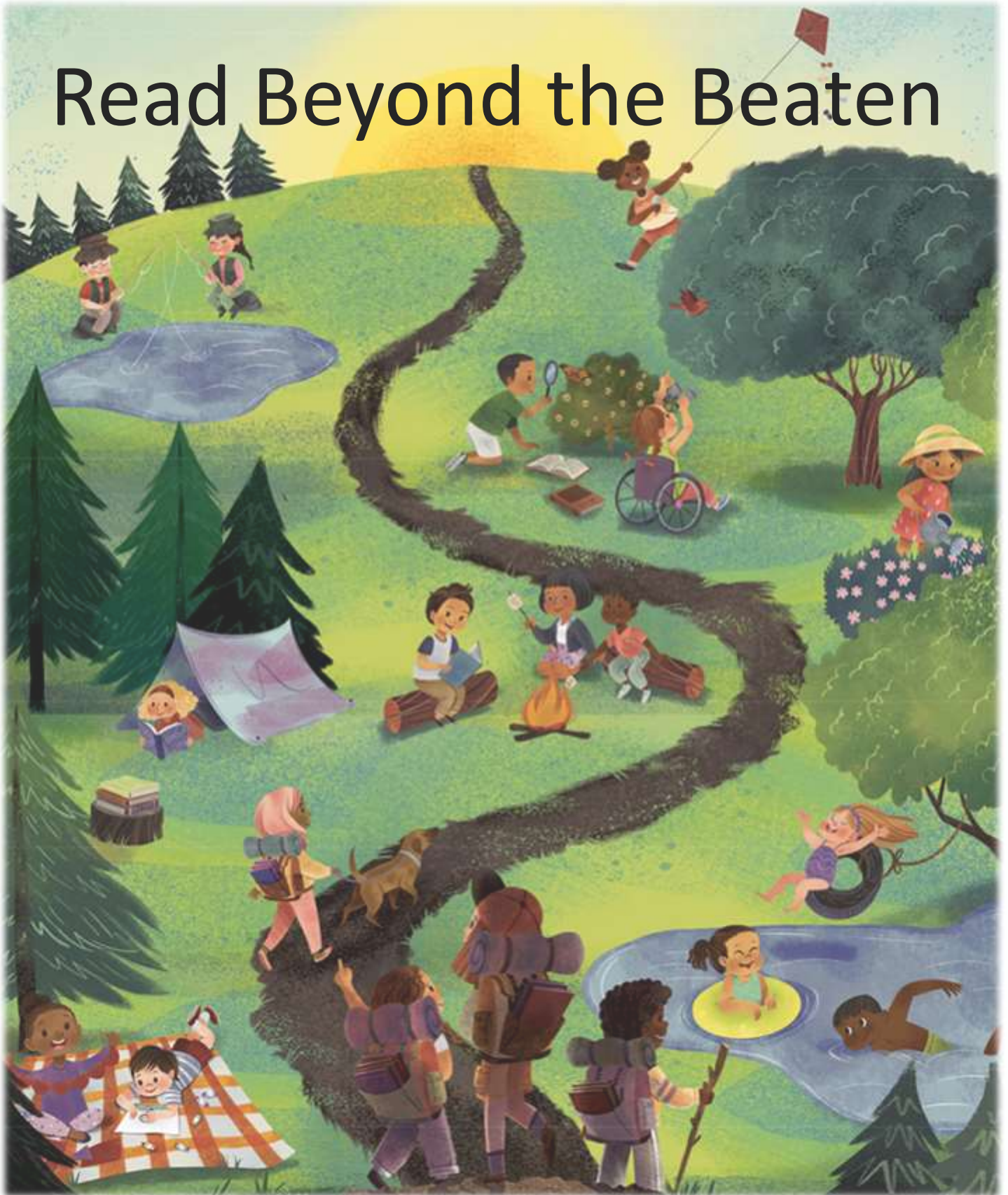

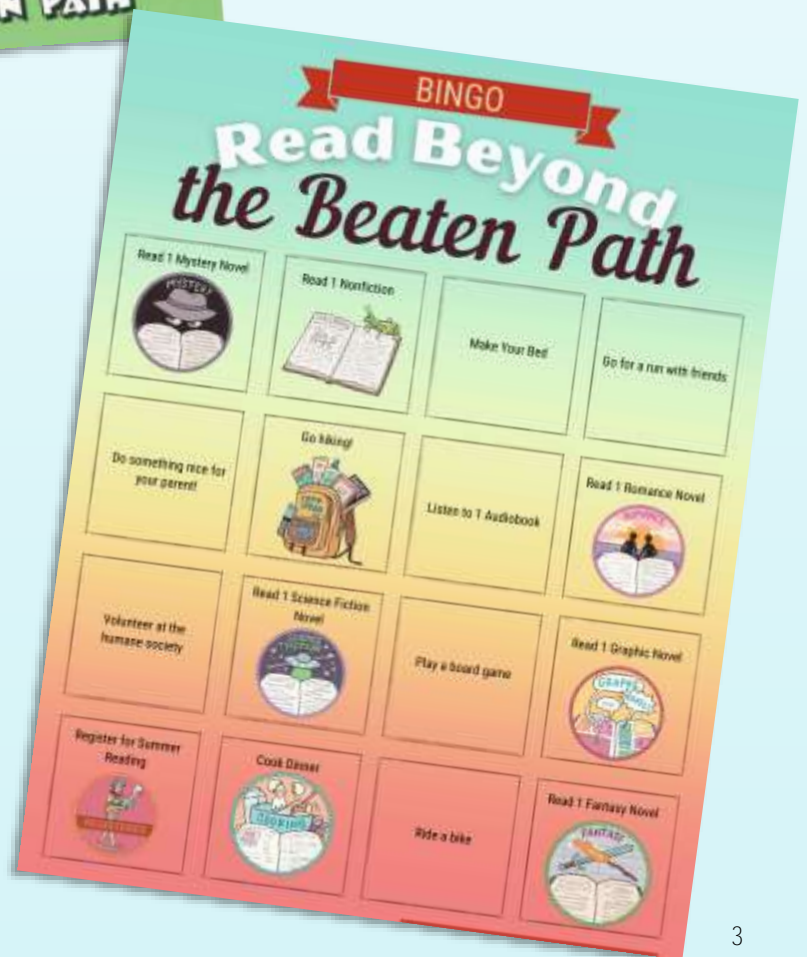


## KIDS

Mark a challenge square when you complete the challenge, and bring in your tracker when you get a bingo!







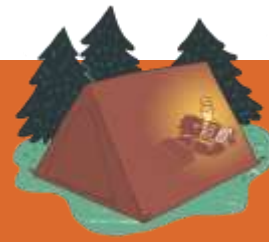


## Pre-School Summer Reading Program
